**DID YOU NOTICE?** In Acts 4:32-6:7 the pattern we noticed last week (apostles proclaim Jesus; intervention by the Holy Spirit and real change; opposition) continues. But notice, again, how the healings and miracles always circle back to Jesus – these aren't carnival tricks but rather serve a specific mission: telling people about Jesus. By the end of this section, the text reads that, so the apostles can be freed up and focus their energy on prayer and the ministry of the word, deacons care for various needs within the community (e.g. waiting tables; the very word deacon means table waiter). The mission, though, is what matters. Let's ask – do all our ministries and programs and jobs/roles at St. George's Church serve the central purpose of telling others about Jesus? Is Jesus unambiguously at the center of all that we do together? Think, pray, and talk with others about that. For this coming week, try to read Act 6:8-8:3.

**About kids in worship...** Children of all ages are always welcome in worship!

- ▶ While you are always welcome to have your child with you, we offer a safe, professionally-staffed **nursery for infants to age 3**, 9:30-11:45 in the lower level. Parents sign in, provide a cell phone, and provide labeled baby gear.
- ▶ We have "**busy bags**" with paper and crayons in the basket by the church doors/ the baptismal font if your kids would like one during the service.
- ▶ During the 10:30 service, we also invite children age 3 to 3rd Grade to join our children's ministry team for **Children's Chapel**. Children begin in worship with parents and then are dismissed at the sermon. They rejoin their families at the Peace so they may also receive Holy Communion.
- ▶ If your child is with you in worship and needs settling, please feel free to use the Narthex (entry hall) or the Welcome Lounge. There are seats & the service audio is broadcast there.

**CHILDREN'S CHAPEL OFFERING** Children's chapel during the 10:30 service now includes an offering. You are welcome to send as little as a coin with your child which will go to **Heifer International**, a ministry that helps people facing hunger gain farming skills. Our kids will be working toward raising money for bee hives. This is not required, but it's a great way to teach kids about *offering* as an aspect of worship.
