JOHN FOR EVERYONE – DID YOU NOTICE? In 1:43-3:21, Jesus has a new disciple, Philip, and Jesus tells Philip that one day he will see angels going up and down on the son of man (meaning Jesus). What a strange image! It echoes the dream of Jacob in Genesis 28 and the point here in John's Gospel is that Jesus is himself the connection between earth and heaven. So much of John's Gospel presumes a basic familiarity with the images and stories from what we call the Old Testament – just like we've said before, John's Gospel presents Jesus as the fulfilment of God's promises not a rupture with ancient Israel. This coming week, try reading 3:22-4:54.

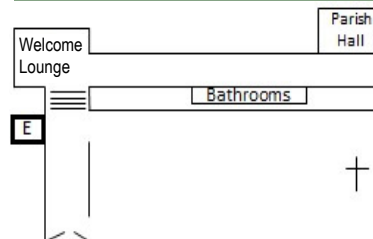

Infants to Age 3 NURSERY IN THE LOWER LEVEL

We offer a safe, welcoming nursery from 9am to (must pick up by) 11:45. Parents should sign in & provide baby gear labeled with the child's or family's name. Please be sure to provide a means of contacting you during the service in case the Nursery staff need to find you. Age 3 is the "ceiling." If potty-trained & 3 yrs of age, parents may decide to move their child up to the Let the Children Come Sunday School program.
