JOHN FOR EVERYONE – DID YOU NOTICE? ? In 12:1-12:50, there is a connection between what Mary does with the perfumed oil and the people who greet Jesus with palm branches: they are worshipping Jesus with all they've got. They are sold out for him; they hold nothing back. This is contrasted with Judas who makes economic arguments. Judas operates not as a steward, but with as one convinced of scarcity. And because he holds back, he can never really see Jesus clearly, that in him and the world he opens up the poor are fed. He can never know the fullness of life and abundance of peace in completely following Jesus. What do we hold back from Jesus? This coming week, try reading 13:1-14:21. And be sure to come to hear Dr. Wes Hill teach at 9:30 in the parish hall!

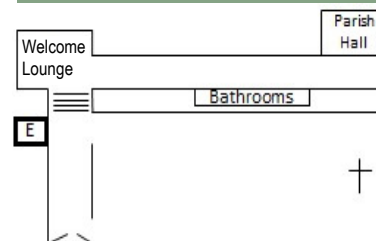
