We offer a safe, welcoming nursery from 10am to (must pick up by)11:45. Parents should sign in & provide baby gear labeled with the child's or family's name. Please be sure to provide a means of contacting you during the service in case the Nursery staff need to find you. Age 3 is the "ceiling." If potty-trained & 3 yrs. of age, parents may decide to move their child up to the Let the Children Come Sunday School program.

Children's Chapel for children age 3 to 3rd grade continues all through summer during the 10:30 service. Children start in worship with their parents and are dismissed for chapel during the service. They return at the peace.
