During services the following conveniences are available:

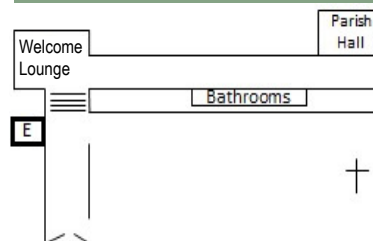
- ◆ Nursery Care for infants through age 3 is provided from 9:00am to 11:45am
