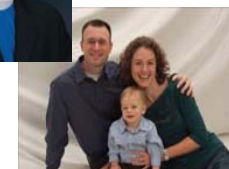

EXHIBIT OF HISTORIC ICONS

Representing more than five centuries of a unique artistic tradition, St. Paul The Apostle Orthodox Church will host an exhibition of more than 100 icons, both ancient and modern, in its sanctuary, located at 4451 Wagner Road in Dayton, August 20 – 22, 2010. The exhibition is free and open to the public from 10 AM to 6 PM on Friday, August 20 and Saturday, August 21, and from 12- 5 PM on Sunday, August 22. Icons (from the Greek word "eikon" meaning "image") are an ancient Christian artistic tradition dating from the time of the Apostles, aimed at communicating the Gospel visually. The historic icons will be surrounded by 36 large icons recently installed on the walls of St. Paul's, commissioned by the parish from noted Russian-American iconographer Dmitri Shkolnik. 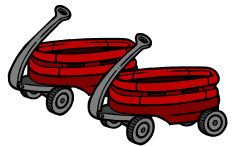


THE RECTOR'S DISCRETIONARY FUND
