FOUR MONTH FOYER GROUPS If you want to get to know some of your fellow parishioners at St. George's in a social setting, our foyer groups offer that opportunity. Those who sign up to be in a foyer group are assigned to groups of about 8 people and those 8 people meet about 4 times over about the next 4 months. You can sign up for a dining out group or for a group that meets in members' homes. For the home meetings, the host generally supplies the main dish and drinks and others are asked to bring appetizer, salad, dessert, or other needed items. Each group sets up its own meetings. When groups are assigned, I will ask one member to organize and host the first meeting. 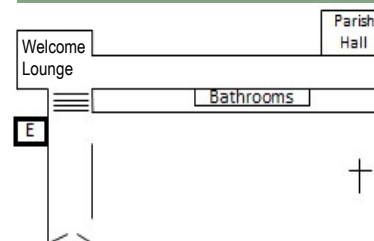

Infants to Age 3 NURSERY IN THE LOWER LEVEL

We offer a safe, welcoming nursery from 9am to (must pick up by) 11:45. Parents should sign in & provide baby gear labeled with the child's or family's name. Please be sure to provide a means of contacting you during the service in case the Nursery staff need to find you. Age 3 is the "ceiling." If potty-trained & 3 yrs of age, parents may decide to move their child up to the Children's Music Program.
