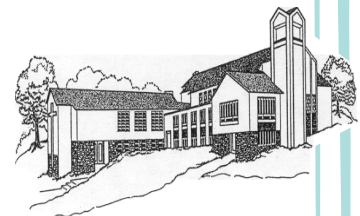
FOUR-MONTH FOYER GROUPS

**From: Anita and Michael Dohn, Missionaries in Health Ministries in the Dominican Republic, from the Diocese of Southern Ohio**

“We had no food in the house at all. What a gift from God when they came to the door!” exclaimed Rosaria, the recipient of one of the food baskets distributed by the AIDS Support groups. She explained that her family had eaten the last of the food and there was nothing left. When the food basket was delivered by other PVVS (*personas viviendo con VIH/SIDA*, people living with HIV/AIDS), she could not help but see it as God acting in her life through the PVVS community. The first baskets were delivered this week. People received the baskets with mixtures of relief, disbelief, thankfulness, and tears. Rosaria’s viewpoint is more along the lines of: “I was hungry and you gave me food.” Actually, that is pretty much our viewpoint, too – despite the complexity of the whole process. 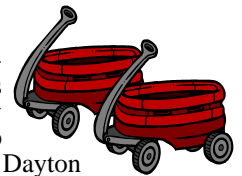
