

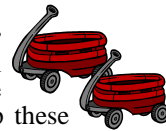

POWER OUTAGE PREPARATION: As we look toward the winter months ahead, when weather-related power outages may occur, as well as other times, The American Red Cross has the following suggestions to be prepared. “Please share these facts with you friends, family members and co-workers. Remember, preparation is the best way to stay safe when there is a disaster. You can begin by gathering an Emergency Kit for times of need.
