LOCAL ARTIST EXHIBIT

There will be a special exhibit featuring the work of Matt Burgy, a local artist and art educator. Matt has a long relationship with St. George's, having led numerous art workshops for children as part of our annual EQUIP Conference, but he is best known to us as the artist who painted all of our new nursery murals. The exhibit of his work will be at Front Street Galleries 1001 E. 2nd St. Dayton 45402 (enter building 100 through the B-C door). The building is an old factory that has been converted into numerous gallery and studio spaces for several Dayton area artists—feel free to check out the many spaces there. Matt's exhibit will be in the "Wright State Alumni" Gallery (take the elevator up to the 2nd floor, and take the door on your right once you exit the elevator).

There are two opportunities to see this exhibit the first is at its opening this Friday Oct 5th from 6-10p.m. and the second is when the exhibit closes on October 21st with a reception from 11:00am to 5:00pm. Any additional showing will be sent via email blast when we find out about them. Matt's exhibit is titled "All of the Above" and features works that made throughout the last 15 years covering many mediums (painting, drawing, sculpture, printmaking, jewelry, and photography—mostly sculpture and painting). The title of the exhibit is a nod to the fact that Matt not only works in many mediums but that many of the works have spiritual undertones (focused on looking above and not below).

About kids in worship......Children of all ages are always welcome in worship!

- ▶ While you are always welcome to have your child with you, we offer a safe, professionally-staffed **nursery for infants to age 3**, 9:30-11:45 in the lower level. Parents sign in, provide a cell phone, and provide labeled baby gear.
- ▶ We have **"busy bags"** with paper and crayons in the basket by the church doors/the baptismal font if your kids would like one during the service.
- ▶ During the 10:30 service, we also invite children age 3 to 3rd Grade to join our children's ministry team for **Children's Chapel**. Children begin in worship with parents and then are dismissed at the sermon. They rejoin their families at the Peace so they may also receive Holy Communion.
- ▶ If your child is with you in worship and needs settling, please feel to use the Narthex (entry hall) or the Welcome Lounge. There are seats & the service audio is broadcast there.
