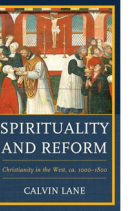
# Upcoming Events

## SUNDAY SCHOOL TEACHER'S WORKSHOP

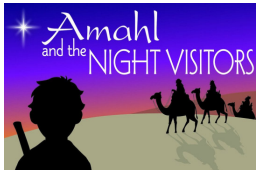
All are welcome to join us for a Teacher's Workshop held November 11 after the 10:30 am service in the Library.

**About kids in worship...**Children of all ages are always welcome in worship!

- ▶ While you are always welcome to have your child with you, we offer a safe, professionally-staffed **nursery for infants to age 3**, 9:30-11:45 in the lower level. Parents sign in, provide a cell phone, and provide labeled baby gear.
- ▶ We have "**busy bags**" with paper and crayons in the basket by the church doors/the baptismal font if your kids would like one during the service.
- ▶ During the 10:30 service, we also invite children age 3 to 3rd Grade to join our children's ministry team for **Children's Chapel**. Children begin in worship with parents and then are dismissed at the sermon. They rejoin their families at the Peace so they may also receive Holy Communion.
- ▶ If your child is with you in worship and needs settling, please feel to use the Narthex (entry hall) or the Welcome Lounge. There are seats & the service audio is broadcast there.

- ◆ Restrooms & drinking fountains are located in the main hall
- ◆ For hearing devices for your pew, please see an Usher.
- ◆ Wheelchair accessible restroom—east end of the Lower Level please use elevator (E, on map to the left)
